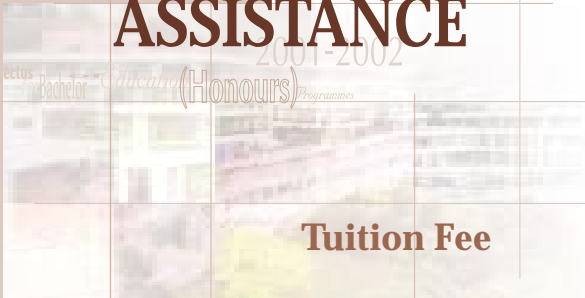


FEES AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE



Tuition Fee

The tuition fee for **Bachelor of Education (Honours) (Primary) Programme (Two-year Full-time)** for the 2000 - 2001 academic year is HK\$ 42,100 per annum.

The tuition fee for **Bachelor of Education (Honours) (Primary) Programme (Three-year Mixed Mode)** and **Bachelor of Education (Honours) (Early Childhood Education) Programme (Three-year Mixed Mode)** for the 2000 - 2001 academic year is HK\$ 28,100 per annum.

The tuition fee for 2001-2002 academic year will be announced later. Under normal circumstances, tuition fee paid is not refundable.

Caution Money

Caution money is charged at first registration. Upon completion of the programme, this money will be refunded to students if they have no outstanding loan or fine in the Institute and is normally converted to the graduation fee.



Financial Assistance

Students with financial difficulties may apply for government grant and/or loan under the Local Student Finance Scheme (LSFS) administered by the Student Financial Assistance Agency. It is a means-tested scheme. Grants are given to cover tuition fee, academic expenses and compulsory Students' Union fee, while loans are intended to cover the cost of living. Students may also apply for a Non-means-tested Loan Scheme (NLS) which is solely used to settle tuition fee. Bursaries, loan funds and emergency fund are also available for students who face unexpected financial hardship.

Scholarships and Prizes

Scholarships, awards and prizes are established to encourage students to pursue academic excellence and to serve as a recognition and encouragement of students' academic achievement.

Scholarships donated by organisations, professional bodies and interested individuals will be awarded to students on the basis of academic merits, personal qualities, commitment to teaching, community service and the needs for financial assistance. Apart from these, we are also supported by funding from outside organizations to enable students with an opportunity to attend the English or Putonghua Language Immersion Programmes overseas or in mainland China.



Other Fees

A schedule of other fees will be listed in the Student Handbook, which will be distributed to students at the beginning of the academic year.
